- Enrol now and gain the skills and knowledge to become a consulting arborist or tree manager. Graduates with this qualification assess trees and produce reports attesting to tree health and associated risks.
- This program is most suited to applicants who have completed a Certificate III or higher-level qualification in a related discipline and possess a minimum of 24 months' relevant industry experience in vegetation management which has included the inspection/assessment and maintenance of trees.
- Applicants must also have access to the internet and a laptop computer and be proficient in computer skills sufficient to conduct research and complete
  word-processed assignments, projects and reports and to enter data into an online portal.

### **Delivery Model**

Multiple delivery modes available to cater for Victorian and interstate students:

#### **Option 1 - Face to Face Classroom Based**

- Training Locations: Metropolitan Melbourne
- Duration: 18 months 2 consecutive days per month plus additional work to be completed between contact days
- Assignments to be completed and submitted via an online learning platform

#### **Option 2 - Virtual Classroom via Microsoft Teams**

- Training Location: Remote Log-in via Virtual Classroom
- Duration: 18 months one training day plus one x 3- hour evening tutorial per month plus additional work to be completed between contact days
- Assignments to be completed and submitted via an online learning platform

### **Entry Requirements**

To be selected for entry into AHC50524 Diploma of Arboriculture, applicants are required to complete a suitability review and a language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) evaluation, prior to enrolment. Applicants must have achieved the following units of competency or their equivalent prior to commencing this qualification:


- AHCARB323 Identify trees or equivalent
